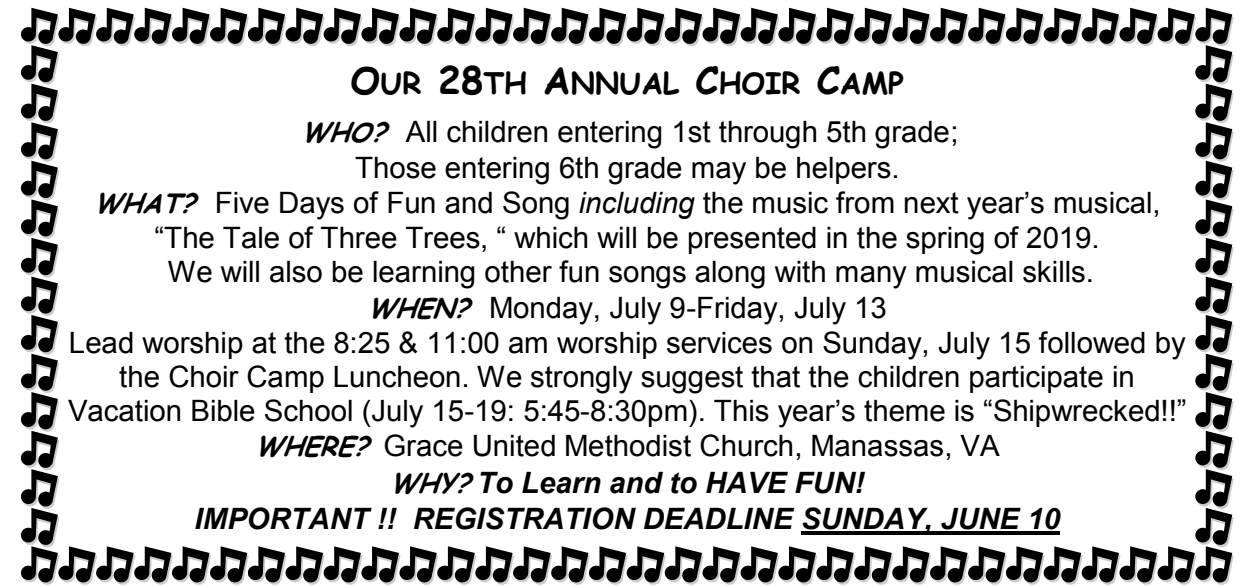

A WORD ABOUT CHAPERONING

To insure the safety of your child, we are limiting each adult chaperone to a total of three children, including any non-choir camp children who may be attending. Children are to remain with the assigned chaperone for the duration of the daily event. Due to their young age and the nature of the activity, we will require that any 1st or 2nd graders be accompanied by either a parent or guardian for both the Freedom Center and Kings Dominion.

The safety and well-being of your child is our first concern. Should we be unable to secure sufficient chaperones for the Freedom Center or Kings Dominion, we will substitute another activity, such as a movie. Thank you for your understanding.

CHOIR CAMP POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Please keep this sheet for future reference

Please note the following very important information . . .

1. **The registration deadline is SUNDAY, JUNE 10.** *No exceptions* will be made to this. The administrators of the different fun activities need to know exact counts of children attending.
2. It is preferable that the children attend the entire week, but if need be, a child may attend certain days. In order to attend the fun activity, the child **MUST** participate in the musical activity.
3. A Medical Release **MUST** be completed for each child.
4. The camp is for **ALL** children who will be in 1st through 5th grade in the fall. The children do not have to be members of Grace Church, nor do they have to have sung in choir before.
5. If rain should cancel any of our outdoor activities, we will stay at the church and watch a movie. A parent or guardian will be called to pick up the child when the film is finished.
6. If your child has special dietary needs or food allergies, please send a snack - as well as lunch - along with your child and check the appropriate box on the registration form.
7. Chaperones are limited to 3 children each. Children are to stay with the assigned chaperone for the duration of the event. Should we not have enough chaperones to meet this ratio, we will substitute an indoor activity, such as a movie.
8. Children in 1st and 2nd grade must be accompanied by either a parent or guardian to both Kings Dominion and the Freedom Center due to the age of the child and the nature of the activities.
9. Scholarship Assistance: We do not want camp fees to stand in the way of any child attending choir camp. If any or all of the fees are too much, please let Rev. Rodgers know and funds will be made available so that your child may attend. This will remain confidential.
